We are extremely proud to have achieved the prestigious ICT Naace Award for our outstanding work in Information Communication Technology.

We have invested in technology to support our children's learning and we encourage the creative use of IC1 through the curriculum. We have a

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computer suite with an interactive whiteboard and the children use digital and video cameras to record and extend their learning. All our classrooms have interactive whiteboards, a bank of computers and a digital microscope. Our extensive library uses the 'Alice' software system for signing books in and out. OFSTED says...
