This is Orville and Wilbur Wright – they invented, built and flew the world's first working aeroplane.

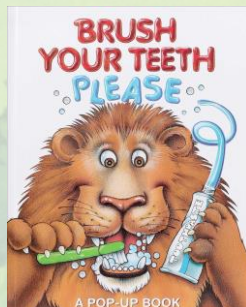
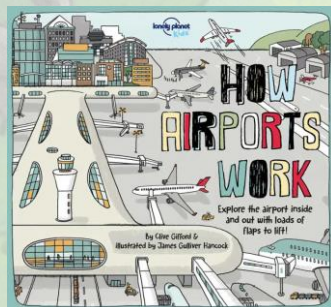
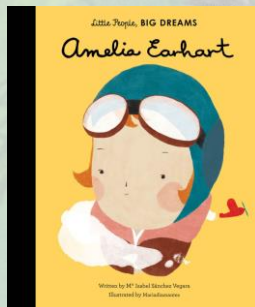
