'Ghostly Gathering' school disco

Every academic year FEPIS hold three discos and we are pleased to announce our first disco will be on **Thursday 19th October** held for all year groups. Tickets will be available via the Weduc app and will be £3.50 each. We always need parent volunteers to help run this event and if you are able to spare some time, please let us know by Facebook/email! We will send out a reminder nearer the time for you to sign up.

In addition to this, there will also be a colouring competition for all children to enter if they wish. The most interesting/best decorated design will win a prize! Two winners from each year group will be picked and then given a prize on Friday 20th October.

For this event to run successfully, we have found that a 'donation day' is really helpful. For this, we ask if your child can bring in either sweets, cakes or crisps (we will assign a specific item for each year group nearer the time). Further information will be sent later on via Weduc but look out for posters across the school and reminders on Facebook.

Christmas Fayre
