We would love to invite you into our school library. Come in, share a story on a cosy seat together and swap your library book!

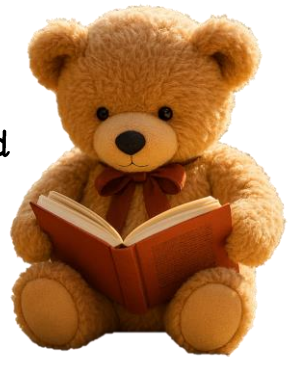
