This week's Star Award was presented to **Poppy Pullen in Woodpeckers class.**



Class Attendance

It is every parent's legal responsibility to ensure that their child/children attend school on a regular basis.

Each week the class who has the best attendance are presented with individual stickers.

Class attendance this week is:

Wagtails -	98.85%
Puffins -	99.63%
Woodpeckers -	93.52%
Blackbirds -	92.13%
Starlings -	98.15%
Falcons -	99.18%
Kestrels -	96.30%
Hawks -	96.30%

This week's stickers were presented to **Puffins class** who achieved **99.63%** attendance. Well done!

National average for attendance is now set at 96%, which means that **Woodpeckers** and **Blackbirds** class fall below this figure. A schools' performance is also based on attendance being 96% or higher, currently our whole school attendance is 97.32%.
